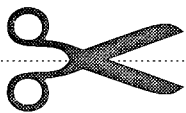

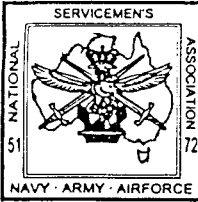
We are also planning to have pick-up and return bus travel from these motels at a small cost of about \$2 each return.

The following are items we wish to submit to be included in the open forum of topics to be discussed at our abovementioned conference.

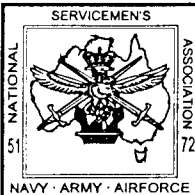
- (a) Why was our original N.S.A.A. badge changed? What was wrong with the original?
